Brother Our great Cheif wabahanine being Dead, we come to address you and to take you, that we still remember the obligations entered into the tween yourvalf and him and in remembrance of which he gave you the land, to form the Connection between our nartion which we hope you have not fair got; Boother we remember that our grate this, promised never to vellour part with any of our lands without consulting your velf and thee five nations, bee now wish to me heat this promis; and we request and begg that you well consider your vely as the voole quardian of our nation and a American Journeys www.americanjourneysorgly comstituted

and appointed attorney for us and in behalf of our nation and Pasterity to do Frankach and negotiate all and every week mallers and Thinges as we may have accosion to do or transach with the whete people; and we do hereby declare and promis; in presence of the greate spirit that we do, and well approve of whatever you may do ar cause to be colone respecting our affairs; and we now thromes in our own names, and for our posterety that we. well not disposse of any of our lands, or take any Steps imacer Councels without your advice and approbation Brothers les are told that the white people do not fully uncless land our Gustom and speaches by a belly we therefore now wish that this wheath may be written for us to Vign, that you may when them that These are over wishes and Intentions The above wheath written at the request of the aforevaid mepasauga Chief, and on the second day of may, following read to h approved and esigned by them, as bending Their nation and pesterely,
